This month, monks from H.H. the Dalai Lama's Namgyal Monastery will create a Chenrezig mandala in the Haffenreffer Museum of Anthropology's Manning Hall gallery to bring compassion for all suffering sentient beings and to overcome anger and hatred in this time of strife.
